THE CITY OF ARP COUNCIL MET FOR A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING OCTOBER 3<sup>RD</sup>, 2022 AT 7:30 PM AT THE ARP FIRE STATION.

ITEM #1 – DENNIS FORD CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER, CERTIFIED A QUORUM AND DALE BROWN LED THE INVOCATION;

ITEM #2 – CRAIG ROBINSON MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING SEPTEMBER 6<sup>TH</sup>, 2022 AND APPROVE PAYING MONTHLY BILLS. ROD LANGLINAIIS SECONDED. MOTION CARRIED 2-0

If at a meeting of a governmental body, a member of the public or of the governmental body inquires about a subject for which notice has not been given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, the notice provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act do not apply to a statement specific factual information given in response to the inquiry; a recitation of existing policy in response to the inquiry; or, any deliberation of or decision about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a subsequent meeting.
